



Artist's Bios

Kip Whelan is a Southern California Ceramics Artist and Professor Emeritus of Rio Hondo College. He attended California State University Long Beach where he received a Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Art Education, a Masters of Art (MA) in Ceramics and a Masters of Fine Arts (MFA) in Ceramics. He was also selected as the Fine Arts Graduate of the Year at California State University Long Beach. He served as the ceramics instructor at Rio Hondo College for over 33 years. Besides teaching and helping raise his two children, he was an active artist exhibiting in over 150 local and national shows. Kip exhibited both his thrown and sculptural pieces. He has won many awards for his ceramic creations.

Dennis Lingo: Upon completing his Bachelor of Arts degree in Metalsmithing at California State University Long Beach in 1976, Dennis Lingo undertook his graduate work while simultaneously building a foundation for his work in the retail jewelry industry. In 1978, he began his independent jewelry design business, Dennis Lingo Designs. In the years that followed, Dennis earned numerous accolades including the Niche Award (an industry award for outstanding design achievement), a Smithsonian Fellowship and first place in jewelry in the Portland Arts Festival to name a few. Dennis frequently participated in selected "by invitation" group shows across the United States. Before Dennis retired around 2006, his pieces were sold throughout the United States through fine crafts galleries. Much of his work found its way into private collections in South America, Europe and Japan.

Alan Mazzetti comes from a family of artists and has been a visual artist all his life. Moving to San Francisco in the eary 1970's to study at the Academy of Art, he stayed to work independently as a graphic designer, then illustrator and currently as a fine arts painter. He has gallery representation in San Francisco, Tucson, Boston, Gualual. Regular exhibitions and marketing through Bay Area Art Consultants. Mercedes Maza studied at the School of Visual Arts in New York City and is recognized in Hawaii as one of its foremost watercolorists. Her work hangs in collections nationwide to include patrons such as Senator Hillary Rodham Clinton, Lionel Richie, Buffy Sainte-Marie and Taj Mahal. Her gallery "Art and Soul" is located on the North Shore of Kauai. www.maza-art.com

Kathy Kirk develops creative images from cutting patterned papers, painting in all media, and/or working with different fabrics. Kathy earned her Bachelor of Arts degree from California State University Long

Beach. Immediately after that she flew out of the country and began her High School Art and Graphic Instructor career in Bendigo, Australia for 3 years. After Australia, she roamed around the world sketching and photographing, finally settling back in Los Angeles. Luckily for her, Walt Disney Imagineering was hiring for their big EPCOT and Tokyo Disneyland projects, so she got on board and had a great ride for 22 years doing art documentation, managing creative staff and set decorating. Upon leaving Disney as the Director, Creative Division, she and her husband, Steve Kirk, and brother in-law, Tim Kirk, started their own Theme Entertainment Company, Kirk Design Inc. Kathy took the President role, and she both managed and did design work in her own company for 11 years. The types and variety of projects that Kathy participated in for her 33 years in the creative industry varied from working and living in Japan as a set decorator to doing design work for the King of Jordan and participating in concept sessions with banking, military, medical, as well as museum and entertainment companies. It was exhilarating but now she can enjoy her own projects.

Tim Kirk received his art degree from California State University Long Beach in the 1970s. He is a designer and illustrator with wide experience in a broad media spectrum---from greeting cards and book and magazine illustration to theme park and museum exhibit design. Tim's paintings based on J.R.R. Tolkien's epic fantasy, *The Lord of the Rings*, appeared in the 1975 Tolkien Calendar published by Ballantine Books. Tim was employed as an imagineer by the Walt Disney Company for 22 years, and still consults on theme park design for Disney theme parks worldwide. (Imagineers are the folks who come up with the ideas for the theme park rides, stores, restaurants, etc.) Tim is a five-time winner of the prestigious Hugo Award for science fiction and fantasy illustration.
